Applicants **must**

- Be a student in good standing and currently enrolled at Morehouse College
- Be enrolled in a demanding course of study
- Demonstrate skilled writing ability

## CITIZENSHIP, CHARACTER AND SERIOUS-MINDEDNESS

Applicants Should

- Demonstrate a desire to make a meaningful contribution to society:  
Both presently and in the future
- Be involved in balance of community, school and work activities
- Pursue goals and aspirations with integrity, resolution, self-discipline and judgment.

## FINANCIAL NEED

Qualifying applicants will have one or more of the following:

- Substantial unmet need
- Heavy student loan burden
- Special financial circumstances

## **APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:**

In order to be considered for a scholarship, an applicant **MUST**

Complete the 2017-2018 scholarship application

Complete an interview with a representative of the GBMCAA

Interview may be in person, by telephone, or video conference

Interview will be scheduled sometime after the submission deadline

Failure to hold an interview by January 2nd 2018 will disqualify any applicant from consideration.

Provide an updated current resume

Provide the official financial aid award letter from Morehouse College

Provide an unofficial Morehouse College transcript

If a new student, provide transcripts from high school or previous college

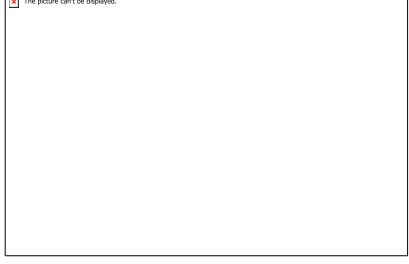
Write a one page personal essay briefly stating your background, your future goals, and your views on why it is important to support Morehouse College

Provide a clear, recently taken, passport-sized headshot of yourself in business attire (i.e. suit, shirt, and tie).
